

FROM REFERENCE TO FINISHED VIDEO

MAKE A SIMPSONS-STYLE VIDEO

*The exact workflow: pick the cartoon style,
then let Calliope shoot the whole thing.*

Getting one good Simpsons-looking frame is easy. Getting **sixty seconds** of them, same character, same colours, same world, cut to a script with narration, is where everyone stalls. This guide is the shortcut.

01 · PICK THE STYLE

02 · BUILD THE TEMPLATE

03 · GENERATE THE VIDEO

1 • LOCK THE LOOK BEFORE YOU SHOOT

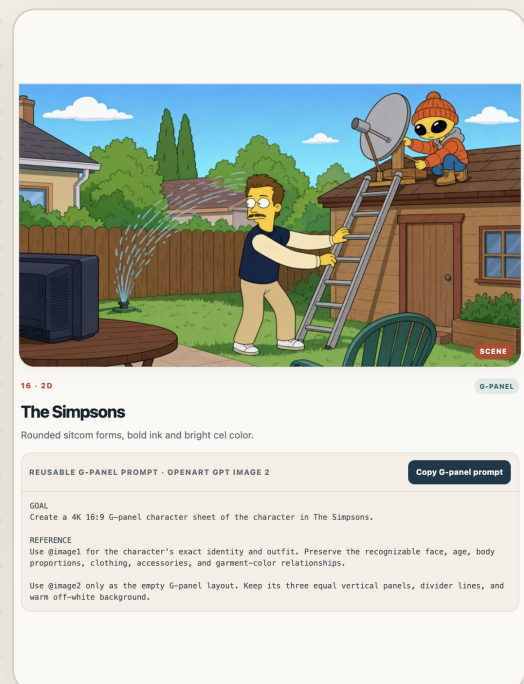
Open cartoonprompts.com and scroll to “The Simpsons”.

Don't describe the style in your own words, because the model will drift. Go to cartoonprompts.com, scroll the style grid past the 2.5D and 3D entries, and stop at **16 • 2D • The Simpsons**: *rounded sitcom forms, bold ink and bright cel color*.

Hit **Copy G-panel prompt**. That block is the thing you'll paste later, and it is what keeps every shot on model.



1.1 • The landing at cartoonprompts.com. Start here, then scroll.



1.2 • The card you want. Copy the **G-panel prompt**.

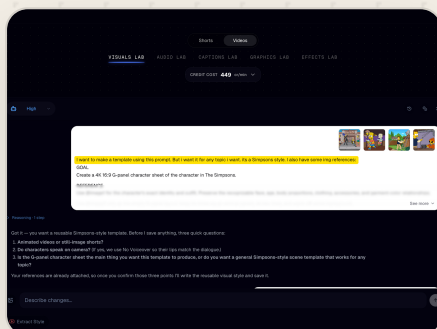
WHY THIS MATTERS

A reusable G-panel prompt is a **character sheet**, not a one-off image prompt. It pins identity, outfit and palette, so scene 7 still looks like scene 1.

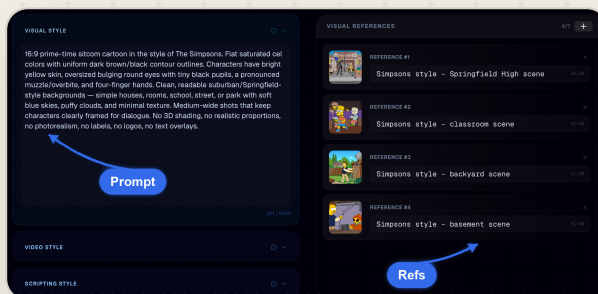
2 • TURN THE STYLE INTO A TEMPLATE

Chat with Calliope until the look is locked in.

- 1 Paste the **G-panel prompt** you copied in step 01, and tell it you want the style reusable for any topic.
- 2 Drop in your **Simpsons reference images** so the model has something to match, not just words.
- 3 Set the quality: **animated on**, **voiceover on**, video **Medium** and image **Extra High**.



2.1 • Paste it in the chat.
Highlighted: the key line.

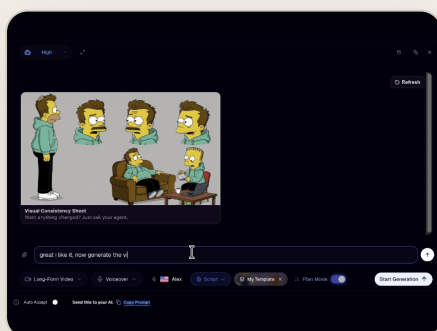


2.2 • Where it lands: the **Prompt** on the left,
the **Refs** on the right.

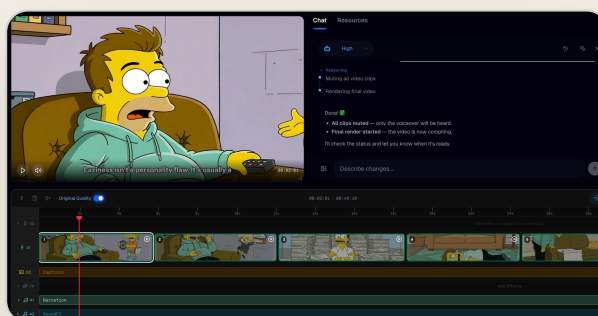
3 • GENERATE THE VIDEO

Creation Lab does the script, the sheet and the shoot.

- 1 Open the **Creation Lab** and hand the agent your idea, or ask it for one.
- 2 Let it build the **script** plus the **character reference sheet**.
- 3 Hit **Start Generation**. Done.



3.1 • The sheet comes first.
Approve it, then **Start Generation**.



3.2 • What lands: clips, captions,
narration and SFX on a real timeline.
